Here is the tentative schedule for the kitchen:
Thursday, 8/10, @ 9 AM- -cleaning, boiling, and counting cabbage leaves, cleaning and preparing onions, haluski making, par-boiling of rice. We will work until the tasks are completed.
Friday, 8/11, @ 9 AM- -rolling of first 600 stuffed cabbage, haluski making, rolling of silverware. We will work until tasks are completed.
Saturday, 8/12, @ 8 AM- -rolling of second 600 stuffed cabbage, haluski making, cabbage frying, onion frying, cucumber cleaning and slicing, hall decoration. At **1:30 PM** crepe making with Daniella. We will work until tasks are completed.
Sunday, 8/13, @ 8 AM- -preparation of pierogis, breading and frying pork chops, preparation of kielbasa and sauerkraut, preparation of salads, packaging of bread, packaging of cake. **11:30 AM-3:30 PM-** -set-up of buffet and servers in place.
 Dish washers are needed every day, all day, until kitchen is cleaned. Men are needed especially to help with roasters. Ending times depend on how many volunteers we have each day. Some tasks may switch days if we get ahead. The kitchen gets very hot especially near the stoves so please dress accordingly.
